

ORDER

THIS CAUSE COMING TO BE HEARD for hearing on Petitioner's motion for summary judgment against the Defendant, Grace Oluwatoyin Lemibola, for violating the Illinois Attorney Act, 705 ILCS 205/1 *et seq.*, and the Defendant having failed to respond to the motion, the Court being fully advised in the premises:

THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Defendant, GRACE OLUWATOYIN AKINLEMIBOLA, is hereby found to be guilty of contempt of court for engaging in the unauthorized practice of law by advertising and holding herself out as authorized to provide legal services to the public through her company, The Grace Akinlemibola Corporation, via a website at www.gacbusiness.com.

2. Judgment is hereby entered against Defendant, GRACE OLUWATOYIN AKINLEMIBOLA, in the amount of \$5,000, payable to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation. By ^{October} ~~September 2~~, 2017, Respondent shall deliver to the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission a certified check or money order payable to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation.

3. The Defendant, GRACE OLUWATOYIN AKINLEMIBOLA, is hereby permanently enjoined from engaging in any acts of unauthorized practice of law in Illinois by identifying herself as an attorney, lawyer, or counselor at law in this State, holding herself out as authorized to provide legal services in this State, or by undertaking or offering to provide legal advice or

services on behalf of others in this State, without first obtaining authorization from the Illinois Supreme Court to practice law.

4. The Defendant, GRACE OLUWATOYIN AKINLEMIBOLA, is hereby ordered to remove any language from the website at www.gacbusiness.com, and any other internet site under her control, wherein she offers to provide legal services to others. She is further ordered to remove any signage or other indicia of authorization to practice law from any location in which she maintains a presence, and to destroy and cease and desist from the use of any business cards or letterhead, or other documents or materials, whether online or otherwise, in which she holds herself out as an attorney, lawyer, or counselor at law. Such order shall remain in effect until such time as the Defendant obtains authorization from the Illinois Supreme Court to practice law.

5. That this Court reserves and retains jurisdiction over the above-entitled action for the purpose of enforcement of this order.
