AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE COMING TO BE HEARD on the agreement of all parties to this cause to enter an Agreed Final Judgment Order, the parties having reported to the Court that they have settled, compromised, adjusted, and adjourned all matters and issues between them pertaining to the above entitled cause; and the parties having further reported to the Court that they have agreed to and consent to be bound by the terms of the agreement hereinafter set forth; and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

NOW THEREFORE, UPON AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES HERETO, THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Respondent, Kristina Kadan, is hereby found to be guilty of minor indirect criminal contempt of court for holding herself out as an attorney, and for engaging in the unauthorized practice of law by providing legal advice and services, to the individuals listed below in the matters specified:
 - A. Manuela Guzman f/n/a Manuela Gonzalez in Manuela G. Gonzalez v. Ruben Gonzalez, Cook County case number 2014D005098.
 - Miguel Arocho in Rosa Arocho v. Miguel Arocho, Cook County case number 2015OP72640.
 - C. Miguel Arocho in *Miguel Arocho v. Rosa Arocho*, Cook County case number 2015OP72648.
 - D. Miguel Arrocho in *In re the Parentage of Arocho*, Cook County case number 2015D79686.
 - E. Ricardo Guerra in connection with a clemency petition and in JP Morgan Chase Bank N.A. v. Araceli Guerra, et al., Cook County case number 2010 CH 5059.
 - Nicole Morrison in connection with a clemency petition and a loan modification.

- Respondent, Kristina Kadan, is hereby sentenced to four years of non-reporting probation and a fine of \$500 and court costs.
- 3. Respondent, Kristina Kadan, is hereby ordered to make restitution totaling \$8,056 to; Manuela Guzman f/k/a Manuela Gonzalez ("Guzman") in the amount of \$1,300.00; Miguel Arocho ("Arocho") in the amount of \$500; Ricardo Guerra in the amount of \$5,320; and Nicole Morrison in the amount of \$936. By September 1, 2017, Respondent shall deliver the restitution in the form of certified checks or money orders payable to the above-named individuals, respectively, to the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary. Payments shall be made in \$200 monthly increments, beginning on December 19, 2017, and due on the 19th of each month until restitution is paid in full. Each monthly payment shall be in the name of the above-named individuals in the order listed herein, and, if the \$200 is allocated in parts to two different individuals, Respondent shall deliver separate certified checks or money orders totaling \$200 for said month.
- 4. Respondent, Kristina Kadan, is hereby permanently enjoined from engaging in any acts of unauthorized practice of law in Illinois by holding herself out as an attorney, lawyer, or counselor at law in this State, or by undertaking the provision of legal advice or services on behalf of others in this State, without first obtaining authorization from the Illinois Supreme Court to practice law.
- 5. Respondent, Kristina Kadan, is hereby ordered to remove any signage or other indicia of authorization to practice law from any location in which she maintains a presence, including any internet site under her control, and to destroy and cease and desist from the use of any business cards or letterhead, or other documents or materials, whether online or otherwise, in which she holds herself out as an attorney, lawyer, or counselor at law, until she obtains authorization from the Illinois Supreme Court to practice law.
- Failure to comply with any provision listed herein will constitute a violation of the terms of probation imposed by this order.
 - 7. No appeals shall be taken from this Agreed Final Judgment Order.

8. That this Court reserves and retains jurisdiction over the above-entitled action for the purpose of permitting the parties to this Agreed Final Judgment Order to apply to this Court for such further orders and direction as may be necessary for the enforcement of this Agreed Final Judgment Order.
